Lake Compounce Finalizes 2020 Schedule, Extends Season Passes Through 2021

Lake Compounce Family Theme & Water Park will conclude 2020 season on Labor Day

BRISTOL/SOUTHINGTON, CT – A roller coaster of a season at Lake Compounce will come to a close next month.

Lake Compounce will finish its 2020 season with a final day of operations on Labor Day, Monday, September 7. To show appreciation for our Season Passholders' support, Lake Compounce will extend all 2020 Silver, Gold & Gold Deluxe Season Passes to include the 2021 Season.

Venus Vortex is slated to open with the rest of Crocodile Cove on Memorial Day weekend 2021. Taking advantage of the shorter season, Lake Compounce and Crocodile Cove will also receive aesthetic upgrades around the park during the offseason.

There is still time to enjoy some summer fun this year, though! Lake Compounce will be open daily through Sunday, August 23 and each weekend, plus Labor Day, through September 7, 2020.
